SCHOOL FEES

2016 School Fees (per family): \$1,000.00 year

These can be paid by year, term or as arranged. Accounts are sent home each term. This covers the costs of running the school, e.g. rates, insurance, gas, electricity, etc.

Comprehensive Fee (per student):

P/1/2/3/4: \$550.00 year

5/6: \$650.00 year

These are payable (preferably) at the beginning of the year. This covers the children's and classroom requisites, and all other tuition costs for the year. Arrangements regarding the method of payment may be made through the school office.

FOUNDATION ENROLMENT

At Holy Rosary we aim to make the transition from Kinder to School as smooth as possible with nurturing staff and a friendly environment.

"Is my child ready for school?" is a question asked by many parents/

At Holy Rosary we recognize that children develop at different rates and learn skills in different ways, and that the age at which a child is ready for school can vary.

Children may be enrolled to start school in February of the year in which they turn five (5), provided that their birthday is before 30th April.

If your child is born after April 30th they may be enrolled to begin school in the February after their fifth (5th) birthday.

TRANSITION PROGRAM

As of Term 3, Holy Rosary is offering Transition mornings for students moving into Foundation in 2017. The goal of this program is to better prepare students through structured activities to help support the transition process.
