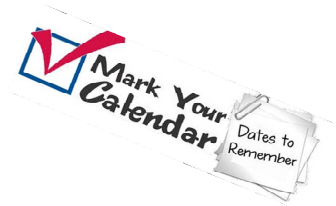

In July this year, Lee Tobin was struck down with a streptococcus A bacteria that kills skin and muscle tissue. Lee was put into an induced coma and spent time in a hyperbaric chamber. She had surgery on a daily basis in an attempt to fight the bacteria.
